

### I. Tempelhof: between memory, history, attachment and symbolism

- Symbol of the violence of a totalitarian regime (used as a concentration camp)
- Memorial to the victims of Nazi regime

1945-1991



Symbolism reversed during the blockade of West Berlin: Tempelhof becomes the symbol of resistance and attachment to the Western European system (parliamentary democracy, freedom).






2011: Creation of the "100% Tempelhofer Feld" association

**2013**: Petition launched

May 25, 2014: Referendum on the future of the site

#### Some additional information on the vote:


- 740,708 votes against the housing project (no)
- 410,801 votes to allow the housing project (yes)

With a 46.7% participation rate

# A strong environmental dimension



- A 300-hectares public park
- >>> Extensive meadows rich in biodiversity
- Rare species identified
- Microclimate in the heart of the city



#### TEMPELHOFER FELD PRESERVATION LAW (THF)

- Recognition of the site's ecological, memorial and historical values
- Sanctuarization of meadows
- Prohibition of all permanent constructions
- Preservation of community gardens

Setting up ZNs and projects


2015 - 2019 - accommodation for refugee claimant

February 2022 - emergency accommodation centre



#### TRANSIENT URBANISM (ZWISCHENNUTZUNG)

- Temporary development project pending definitive project
- Site maintenance
- Place still integrated into the living space of local residents





#### HERITAGE VS NEW NEIGHBORHOOD: A BALANCE IN PERSPECTIVE

- A process of patrimonialisation :
  - A large building at the heart of strong symbolism
  - A listed site
  - UNESCO becomes a tool
- The city's housing policy:
  - A vast field in the heart of the city
  - Respond to the demand for housing in Berlin
- A controversial balance:
  - Citizen consultation initiatives
  - Vision 2030+
  - Cultural and artistic events
